Privacy Policy – Register of Awards

This is a register and privacy policy in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

1. Register controller

3. Name of the register

Register of Awards of Aalto University's guild of Electrical Engineering.

4. Legal basis and purpose of processing personal data

The legal basis for the processing of personal data in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation is the legitimate interest of the controller.

The purpose of the processing of personal data is to maintain a list of honors awarded by the Aalto University Electrical Engineering Guild.

5. Data content of the register

The following data is stored in the register:

- Full name
- Honorary award
- Year of award

6. Regular sources of data

The data stored in the register is obtained from the minutes of the board of Aalto University's guild of Electrical Engineering. The data is added to the register only after the honoree has given their consent.

7. Disclosure and transfer of data outside the EU or EEA

The data is available on the website of Aalto University's guild of Electrical Engineering. The data is not stored outside the European Union or the European Economic Area.

8. Principles of register protection

The register is handled with care. The data is stored only in electronic form on reliable third-party internet servers that comply with EU data protection legislation. The data cannot be read by anyone other than the persons responsible at Aalto University's guild of Electrical Engineering.

The controller ensures that only relevant persons have access to the register.

9. Right of access and right to request correction of data

Every person included in the register has the right to check their data stored in the register and to request the correction of any incorrect data or the completion of any incomplete data. If a person wishes to check the information stored about them or request a correction, the request must be sent in writing to the controller. If necessary, the controller may ask the person making the request to prove their identity. The controller will respond to the customer within the time limit specified in the EU Data Protection Regulation (usually within one month).

10. Retention period of the register

The register only stores the data of persons who have given their consent to the display of their data. The data in the register will be destroyed upon request.
